### Project Activities

The City of Orlando, Florida commissioned an environmental sustainability memo to examine existing best management practices at city parks and provide recommendations for improving park environmental sustainability. The Drummond Carpenter team provided the city with a report of generalized best management practices for municipal parks. This report included suggestions related to park infrastructure improvements, landscaping/vegetation techniques, and stormwater management practices. Additionally, the consulting team selected six pilot parks, of varying size and usage, for on-site visitation. For the six pilot parks, the consulting team provided photographs and reports detailing each park's existing sustainability practices as well as opportunities for improving environmental sustainability at the park.

### Outcomes

The final outcome was a memo detailing opportunity for improving environmental sustainability at City of Orlando parks and recreation facilities. The report provides detailed examples of existing best management practices and deficiencies which can be utilized to inform municipal parks improvement and training Parks and Recreation employees.
